### **Pre-Public Examinations - 10th March – 21st March 2025**

The second series of Pre-Public Examinations take place from 10th March until 21 March. We have tried to timetable the longer examinations during morning sessions where possible. However, please note that on occasion an afternoon examination may run into Champions' Hour but we have tried to limit this as much as possible.

After a successful February half term supporting NEA subjects, 78 students accessed over 180 sessions which equates to an additional 450 hours of teacher support.
