Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you of a change in the way we receive communication from parents/carers regarding your child not participating in practical PE. From 3 February, if your child is unable to take part practically in PE then you must inform us via email by 8.40am on the day they have PE. In the email, please include your child's name, class teacher, the date and reason for non-participation. This email must be from a parent or carer and should be sent to their class teacher. In these situations, the expectation is that we will do our best to include your child in the PE lesson - officiate, timer, peer mentor - so please still bring in a PE kit. The PE teacher will acknowledge the email as soon as possible.
